- Is a Green New Deal Possible?


Utilities are Strategic Assets

- Essential providers of network services
- Need to sell more kWhs to stay in business
- What is their 21st century business model?
- A 21st century grid requires universal broadband connectivity.
- Will the PUC champion a new model for the grid?

My small steps

- EV for transportation;
- Level 2 charger for home charging;
- PV for local generation;
- Batteries for local storage & grid support;
- Hybrid hot water heater;
- Nest thermostat;
- Wood Pellet stove;
- The results can be greater than the sum of the parts.







Benefits

- 100% utilization of our PV, even when the grid is down;
- Lower cost of Electricity;
- Carbon foot print reduced;
- Bolt costs less than 4 cents per mile to drive;
- \$120 per month in avoided gasoline costs;
- PV paid off in less than 7 years;
- Necessary but not sufficient.

Additional Actions


- Champion equality
