Comprehensive Weatherization

Home Performance with ENERGY STAR

Work with an Efficiency Excellence Network (EEN) contractor

Receive 75% of the project cost back, up to \$4,000

Income-eligible residents can receive 75% of project costs back, up to \$9,500

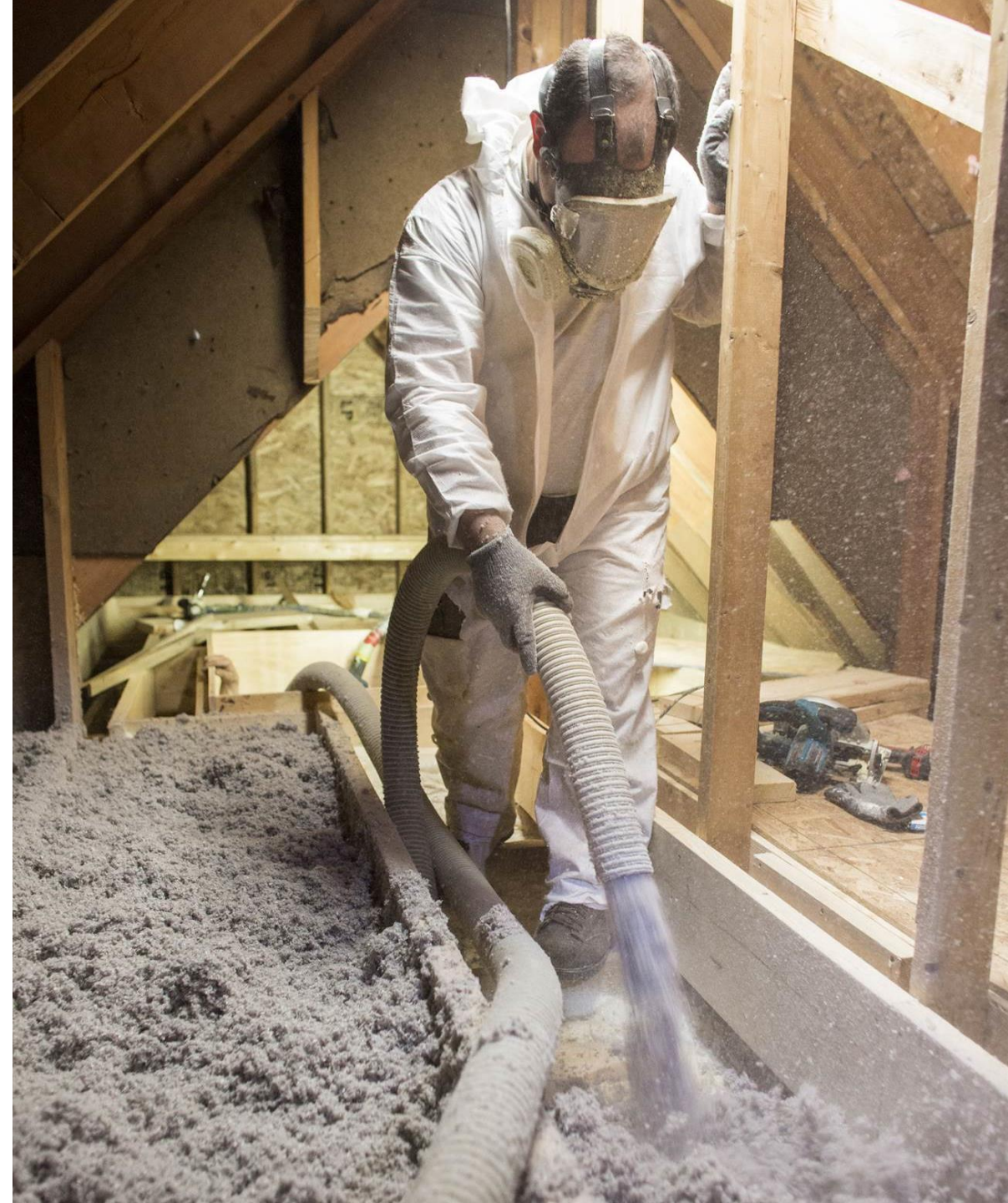
Building Performance

Comprehensive weatherization for buildings with multiple units

Work with an EEN contractor

Receive 75% of project costs back, up to \$5,000.

Financing Options

Home Energy Loan

Starting at 0% interest

No minimum loan amount

Finance up to \$20,000

Eligible projects:

- weatherization
- heat pumps
- heat pump water heaters
- wood heating systems
- ENERGY STAR appliances

Weatherization Repayment Assistance Program (WRAP)

Pay for a project monthly on your utility bill.

Heat pumps can be financed when paired with weatherization.

Reduces or eliminates upfront costs

Restrictions apply, including 12 months of positive bill payment with a participating utility (Burlington Electric Department, Green Mountain Power, Ludlow Electric, Vermont Electric Coop, and VGS)

Business Energy Loan

Low-interest, \$0 down loans for your business or non-profit

Participating lender: VSECU

\$50,000 loan cap

Flexible terms up to 10 years, 100% financing

Flood Recovery Offers

Enhanced incentives for flood-impacted homeowners, tenants, rental property owners, businesses and contractors

Homeowners & Tenants

Up to \$10,000 per household for HVAC & appliances for qualifying low- and moderate-income Vermont homeowners and renters.

In addition:

Up to \$5,000 back on heat pump water heaters

Up to \$10,000 on home electric systems

Up to \$9,500 on weatherization projects.

Rental Property Owners

Qualifying low- and moderate-income rental units (based on rent levels) are eligible to receive:

- Up to \$10,000 per unit or single-family rental for water heating, appliances, and ductless heat pumps.
- Up to \$10,000 per building or single-family rental for central heating systems damaged by flooding.
- Up to \$4,500 for heat pump water heaters.

Commercial

100% of costs, up to \$4,000 per product, for the purchase of new qualifying equipment.

Limit of up to 4 products per customer (Max \$16,000 or up to \$4,000 x4)

Offer may be stacked on top of standard offers.

Qualifying equipment includes heating & cooling, water heating, refrigeration and commercial kitchen equipment.

Contractors

Earn up to \$1,000 for heating and hot water system replacement/new installation, and \$250 per adder for resiliency and electrification.

Low- and moderate-income households eligible for Efficiency Vermont flood incentives.

\$1,500 cap/household

\$15,000 cap/company
